#### PURPOSE:

This document is a complement to the DMLC Part I and is giving more detailed information for auditing ships managed by our Company.

Swiss Maritime Laws and Regulations are structured as follows:

- The Swiss Maritime Statute (Navigation Act, SMS)
- The Navigation Ordinance (SMO)
- Collective Agreements of Employment (CAE) between members of the Swiss Shipowners Association (or ABC Maritime AG), and the Swiss section of Nautilus International.
- Circulars issued by the Swiss Maritime Navigation Office SMNO

In addition to the above Laws and Regulations which are stated in detail by the Administration on the DMLC Part I, the Company has issued internal instructions for the Masters, giving details for the implementation of the Regulations. For easy reference, copies of these instructions are attached as an Annex to this Document.

When submitting the DMLC Part II to the Administration, the shipowner will in particular indicate and submit additional information as follows:

- a) when ongoing compliance shall be verified (state window);
- b) the Designated Person Ashore (DPA) as announced to the Administration;
- c) Procedures to be followed when non-compliance is noted;
- d) to ensure ongoing compliance, the shipowner will also include the application of new general international requirements concerning progress in technology concerning security at the workplace, if available.

# **Applicability**

In accordance with Standard A5.1.3.1, and Appendix A5-I of the MLC, the working and living conditions of seafarers that must be inspected and approved by the Flag State before certifying a ship in accordance with this Standard are mentioned below. Complementary information for each subject, giving reference to Company internal documents concerned.
